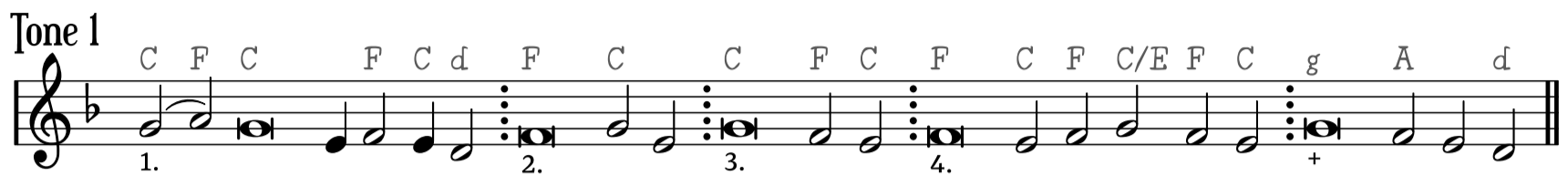

V. (1) *For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.*

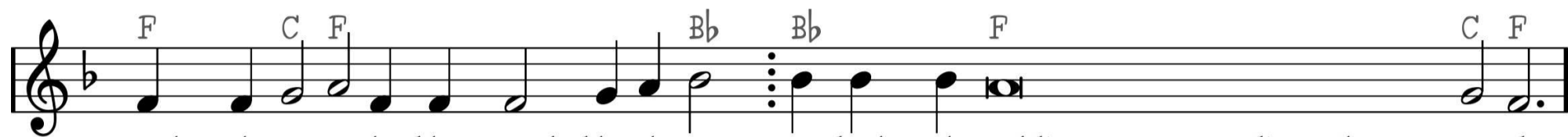

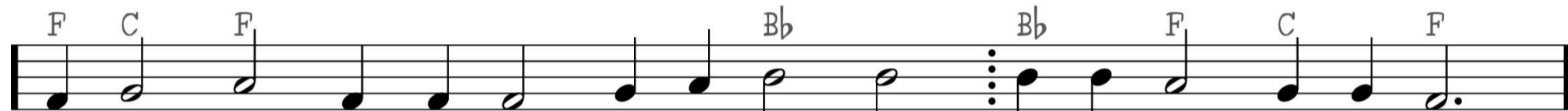


# Ressurrection Troparion

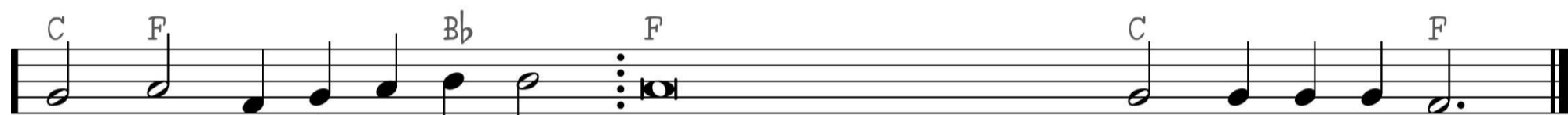

1. Glo - ry to Thy Kingdom! 2. Glory to Thy Providence, O only Lo - ver of menkind.

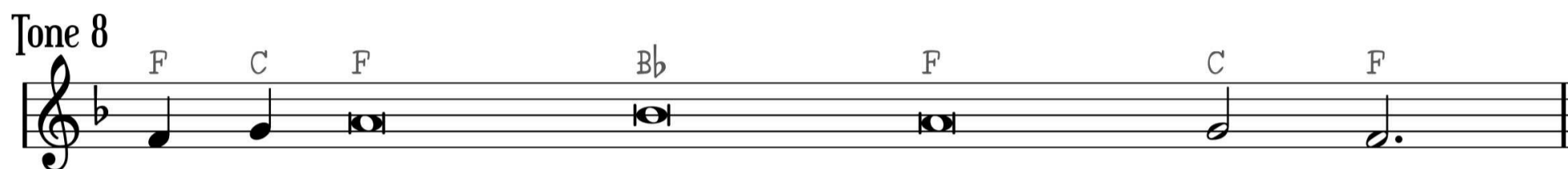
